## National evidence on confidence



- Robust causal evidence
  - Neighbourhood policing with a strong emphasis on problem-solving
- Promising causal evidence
  - Information on local priorities & police actions
- Association evidence
  - Neighbourhood policing
  - Procedural fairness
  - Positive neighbourhood perceptions
  - Positive police contact

## Local confidence surveying



- Announced in the Policing Green Paper
  - “[The] national target will be supplemented by confidence data collected by each individual force at [the] local level”
- The Minimum Technical Requirement
  - Inclusion of the British Crime Survey question
  - Use of random samples at the CDRP/CSP level
  - Samples to be broadly representative
  - Results to have a confidence interval of +/-4 per cent
  - The data to be released by the end of February 2010

## The Technical Advisory Group



- Governance – the Home Office PCSB
- Wide-ranging specialist representation
- Practitioner engagement – regular events, an online community of practice
- TAG issues:
  - ‘Don’t Know’ responses
  - Areas with small populations (e.g. the City, Scilly Isles)
  - Calculating rolling samples
  - Explaining the differences between survey results

## The grant process



- Home Office funding will be released in 2 phases – 50% in October, 50% in March
- Initial 50% - to be released subject to acceptable application demonstrating likelihood that the MTR will be achieved.
- Remaining 50% - to be released subject to acceptable application demonstrating compliance with the MTR.
- Applications to be assessed by the TAG, on behalf of the Home Office Public Satisfaction and Confidence Board.
